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Boarding Policies

In an effort to ensure the safety of your pet, Maple Small Animal Clinic has established the following policies in regard to the boarding of all animals:

Emergency Contacts:

We **require** that you provide us with the telephone number of two people other than yourself who have agreed in advance to pick up your pet in the event of an impending storm or an emergency here in the clinic. If we are unable to reach you or your other contacts, your pet will be evacuated with clinic staff and the cost for this evacuation will be \$ 1,000.00, plus an additional \$ 100 per day.

In the event of a hurricane that may impact the New Orleans area, Maple Small Animal Clinic will close approximately 2 days before estimated landfall. We will NOT board any animals during an impending storm or an emergency situation. This is to ensure the safety of all the animals and staff.

Microchips:

We require a microchip for every boarded animal. A microchip must be implanted in any pet that has not been previously micro-chipped. If you refuse this, **your pet WILL be micro-chipped at your expense if your pet is evacuated with us** in the event of an emergency situation. This is to ensure permanent identification of each animal. Even if you never board your animal, we strongly recommend this service because it is a sure way to identify them should they ever get lost.

Boarding Exams and Illness while boarding:

Upon arrival, your pet will be examined by a veterinary assistant. If your pet has an existing medical problem, or becomes ill, your pet will be evaluated by a Doctor. Pets that become ill while boarding will be treated at the discretion of the Doctor on staff, at the client's expense. The Doctor will attempt to contact you at the emergency number you provide to discuss your pet's condition.

Vaccinations:

Proof of current vaccinations is required. Boarding pets must be current on all vaccinations. If your pet is not currently vaccinated, your pet will be vaccinated at your expense at the Doctor's discretion. This is to ensure the safety of all pets in the hospital.

What to bring with your pet:

We recommend that you only bring prescription medicine and food with your pet. We recommend that you do not bring your own bedding, toys, collars, leashes, etc. If you choose to do so, we are not responsible for items lost.
